### **SECURITY ENGINEER – IS ENGINEER**

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	<p>The Security Engineer will provide critical support to a high-visibility Department of Navy (DoN) initiative. Responsibilities will include leading the execution of IT (network, system, communication) security assessments and the data gathering, assembly, and submission of C&amp;A packages. As a key member of a Security Engineering Team, the candidate must be self-motivated, flexible, and team-oriented as they participate on all related C&amp;A efforts. The individual filling this position will need to conduct IA questionnaires and interviews with DoN personnel, perform System Test &amp; Evaluations (ST&amp;Es) and help translate collected data points into compliance documents as they pertain to the DoD Information Assurance, Certification and Accreditation Process (DIACAP). This position also involves frequent interaction and close coordination with various government managers e.g. ISSOs, System Owners, IAMS, and Designated Approval Authority representatives.</p> <p>The primary responsibilities for the Security Engineer include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Full and in-depth comprehension of DoN policies, directives, and instructions as it pertains to C&amp;A process</li> <li>➤ Performing data gathering techniques (e.g., questionnaires, interviews, document reviews) in preparation for C&amp;A Package Assembly</li> <li>➤ Conducting Technical Assessments and Reviews to include ST&amp;E's</li> <li>➤ C&amp;A Packages Assembly</li> <li>➤ Assistance in preparing executive level briefings on the status of all C&amp;A related activities</li> <li>➤ Performing other related duties as assigned by the PM and Lead Sr. Security Engineer</li> </ul>
<b>REQUIREMENTS</b>	<p><b>WORK EXPERIENCE</b></p> <p>Minimum four (4) years of C&amp;A/ST&amp;E experience, with three (3) of those years in support of DoD and/or DoN agencies. Must have in-depth knowledge of DoD IA policies (e.g. DoDI 8510.01, DoN DIACAP Handbook, DoDI 8500.2, COMSCINST 5239.3A). Exposure to and experience with RETINA, DISA Gold Disk, DISA STIGS and Security Readiness Review scripts, as well as protocols (TCP/IP, SSL), intrusion detection systems, firewalls, routers and switches. Relevant experience with Windows operating systems, Unix, Linux, Oracle, and SQL. Approved status as a Navy Certification Agent or approved Navy Validator is a plus.</p>
