DESCRIPTION	<p>The Senior Security Engineer will provide leadership in critical support to a high-visibility Department of Navy (DoN) initiative. Responsibilities include leading the execution of IT (network, system, communication) security assessments and the data gathering, assembly, and submission of the C&A packages. As the lead member of a Security Engineering Team, the candidate must be self-motivated, flexible, and team-oriented as they orchestrate all activities related to C&A efforts. The individual filling this position will need to conduct IA questionnaires and interviews with DoN personnel, perform System Test & Evaluations (ST&Es) and help translate collected data points into compliance documents as they pertain to the DoD Information Assurance, Certification and Accreditation Process (DIACAP). This position also involves close coordination with the government manager(s) in order to anticipate and prepare for upcoming events, requirements, challenges, and mandated international scope. The Senior Security Engineer will be the central figure working with the IAM and Designated Approval Authority (DAA) representatives in submitting C&A packages for approval.</p> <p>The primary responsibilities for the Senior Security Engineer include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Full and in-depth comprehension of DoN policies, directives, and instructions as it pertains to C&A process ➤ Plan and lead the data gathering activities (e.g., questionnaires, interviews, document reviews) in preparation for assembling C&A Packages ➤ Organize and lead Technical Assessments and Reviews ➤ Oversee and manage C&A Package Assembly ➤ Prepare and participate in executive level briefings on the status of all C&A related activities ➤ Performing other related duties as assigned by the PM

Extensive experience with RETINA, DISA Gold Disk, DISA STIGS and Security Readiness Review scripts, as well as protocols (TCP/IP, SSL), intrusion detection systems, firewalls, routers and switches. Relevant hands-on experience with Windows operating systems, Unix, Linux, Oracle, and SQL. Experience in a</p>
