A key responsibility will be the vulnerability scanning/assessment, and remediation of systems in preparation for submission of C&A packages. The candidate must be self-motivated, flexible, and willing to support the Security Engineer Teams on all related efforts.</p> <p>The primary responsibilities for the IA Analyst include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Perform DISA Gold Disk assessment on Windows-based assets ➤ Perform eEye Digital Retina assessment of hardware and software assets ➤ Perform manual assessment using the appropriate DISA STIG or Security Checklist in cases where automated tools cannot provide proper assessment of security controls ➤ Assist MSFSC Afloat IA Team in the development, testing, and implementation of remediation actions based on the results of ongoing monitoring activities, assessment of risk, and outstanding items in the Security POA&M. ➤ Conduct IA Life Cycle Management and Risk Mitigation tasks consisting of scanning, reports, analysis, assessment, testing, STIG check of finalized tested platforms, and perform remediation and/or mitigation, and rescans. ➤ Updating the Security POA&M based on the results of the continuous monitoring process, to include proper documentation of mitigation strategies, changes to IA Controls, and overall assessment of Residual Risk. ➤ Performing data gathering techniques (e.g., questionnaires, interviews, document reviews). ➤ Supporting the Security Engineering Team(s) in the collection, review, and assembly of data pertaining to the C&A Package(s)
REQUIREMENTS	<p>WORK EXPERIENCE</p> <p>Minimum three (3) years of C&A/ST&E experience, with two (2) of those years in support of DoD and/or DoN agencies. Must have in-depth knowledge of DoD IA policies (e.g. DoDI 8510.01, DoD 8500.2, DoN DIACAP Handbook, COMSCINST 5239.3A). Experience with RETINA, DISA Gold Disk, DISA STIGS, and Security Readiness Review scripts. Approved status as a Navy Certification Agent is a plus.</p>
